- <u>Muslim Student Association at Buffalo</u>: A link to a Yahoo group, on this Muslim Student Association site contained information for an upcoming event. This link contained the following information:
 - o The Fifth Annual Convention of Reviving the Islamic Spirit is scheduled to take place from December 22nd to 24th 2006 at South Building, Metro Toronto Convention Centre. There will be various prominent Muslim Scholars throughout the world that will be speaking at this event. The following Muslim Scholars are amid many Scholars who will anticipate:
 - **Dr. Tariq Ramadan** –His maternal grandfather Hassan al Banna, founded the Muslim Brotherhood in Egypt which has ties to extremist Islamic groups.
 - His father <u>Said Ramadan</u> was also a prominent figure in the Muslim Brotherhood.
 - O Was expelled from Egypt for promoting Anti-Egypt government movement.
 - In September 2006, a US consular officer has denied Dr. Tariq Ramadan's visa application solely on his action, which constituted providing material support to terrorist organization.
 - In February 2004 he accepted the tenured position of Luce professor of religion at the Joan B. Kroc for International Peace Studies at the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, USA
 - In July 2004 his visa was revoked by the State Department and was forced to resign the position
 - Shaykh Hamza Yusuf A converted Muslim, born in Washington and raised in Northern California:

- Studies abroad for 10 years, travel frequently to major North American and European cities to teach and lecture to both Muslims and non Muslims.
- He is a founder of Zaytuna institute, the study of core Islamic sciences.
- Imam Zaid Shakir Is currently a Political profesor at Zaytuna Institute:
 - Studied Islam in Syria and Morocco
 - Was a political profesor at sourthern connecticut State university in New Heaven prior to his depature to Syria
 - Served as Imam at al-Islam mosque in New Heaven.
- Imam Siraj Wahaj The Imam of Masjid Al-Taqwa an Arabic term for God-Conseciousness in Brooklyn, New York.
 - He travels widely, lecturing and preaching at Islamic centers, conventions, fundraisers and universities.
 - He has been Vice President of ISNA since 1997 and appeared on several national television talk shows and interviews

The message advertising this event was posted by a member of the Muslim Student Association at Buffalo who identifies herself as Adeela Khan.
